Our senior class's completion of the college application process now transitions into the admissions waiting game. The best of luck to the Class of 2026! They ended the fall sports season with **TWO CIF championship titles**. Our **Girls Flag Football Team** clinched the **D-2 Championship**, managing to come back from a shaky start of the season to earn a CIF crown. The **Girls Tennis Team** dominated the rankings and handily defeated Portola for the **D-1 Title**. The **Sea Queens** were qualifiers for the state title - the first time in CDM's history! An epic Battle of the Bay took place as two storied NMUSD high schools fought for the CIF Open Division Water Polo Championship. **Newport Harbor's Boys Water Polo Team**, ranked first in the nation, was the victor over the **CdM Boys Water Polo Team**, ranked third in the nation. It was a historic celebration!

Newport Harbor Extends Its Water Polo Legacy

A long-standing rivalry in boys water polo—one steeped in tradition, talent and countless championship moments—gained a memorable new entry as Newport Harbor and Corona del Mar faced off for the CIF-SS Open Division crown on Saturday, November 15, 2025. On a rainy evening at Mt. SAC, Newport Harbor delivered a commanding performance, relying on relentless defense and a powerful two-meter game to earn a 10–3 win and secure the program's 16th top-division title.

For these two schools, whose "Battle of the Bay" rivalry resonates across every sport, any victory carries weight. But this triumph felt especially meaningful for the Sailors (30–1). Not only did it mark their 20th straight win over their crosstown opponent, it also cemented back-to-back Open Division championships—four in the last five years—and provided a storybook finish for a senior-heavy roster.

As the final horn sounded, roughly a dozen seniors rushed toward the deck before leaping into the pool in celebration, a fitting culmination for a group that has grown up competing side by side.

"This team is truly special as it is a very heavy senior-led team," said Coach Ross Sinclair. "These guys have been playing together since they were 10 years old and have incredible chemistry and connection. They lead by example and have been the catalyst for the success that we have had all season long."

Sinclair was especially proud of the way they finished the season.

"The championship game where we beat CDM 10-3 was a culmination of everyone's hard work and all in commitment to reach success," he said. "I could not be more proud of the boys and their families that poured their heart and soul into this process."

Newport Harbor's defensive stand was one of its strongest of the year. The Sailors held Corona del Mar (26–7) to its lowest scoring output of the season and shut the Sea Kings out on all six of their power-play opportunities. It marked a decisive improvement from the teams' previous meetings, where Newport Harbor won 14–9 and 13–7 but allowed significantly more offensive freedom.

Senior leaders set the tone on both ends of the pool. Four goals from Kai Kaneko paced the offense, while Netzer, Kaneko and Dash D'Ambrosia each grabbed two steals. Netzer added three field blocks, and D'Ambrosia contributed two more, providing strong support for senior goalkeeper Connor Clougherty in his first season as the team's starter.

With talent, chemistry and experience converging at the perfect moment, Newport Harbor's seniors capped their final chapter in historic fashion—together, undefeated in the rivalry one last time, and once again at the top of the sport.

ARA-290

ARA-290, also called Cibinetide, is a promising new peptide therapy gaining attention for its ability to reduce inflammation, support nerve health and ease chronic pain. Although it was inspired by a natural hormone in the body, it was specifically designed to deliver healing and repair benefits without the risks that come with many traditional medications. To understand ARA-290, think of it as a “*repair signal*” for the body. The Story Behind CdM's Oldest & Perhaps Most Beloved Building

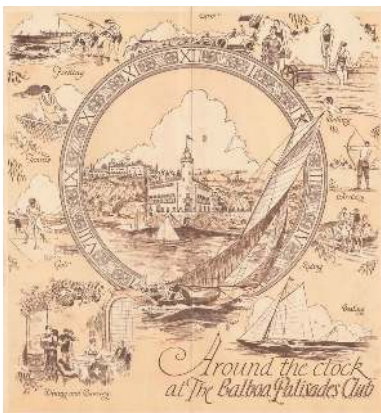


One of the oldest structures in Newport Beach is the iconic Kerckhoff Marine Laboratory (over 100 years old) on the edge of China Cove near the harbor entrance. Here are five things you might not know about the history of the granddaddy of Corona del Mar buildings.

1. (And this may seem unrelated, but we'll tie it all together in a sec.) In 1907, Corona del Mar's original developer, George Hart, constructed the two-story, 18-room Hotel Del Mar on the bluffs with views of the harbor and ocean to attract would-be home-lot buyers and serve as a real-estate sales office.

2. Eight years later, with few hotel guests and fewer parcel sales, the hotel was rebranded the Palisades Tavern. That failed as well.

3. In 1925, developers came up with a new idea: turn the hotel and surrounding property into a private club. The ambitious plans for the Balboa Palisades Club consisted of a three-story Spanish-style clubhouse with 50 guest rooms, bungalows, a bowling alley, billiard tables and dining and living rooms. And below the bluff, a boathouse/bathhouse would feature boats on the bottom level, a second-floor bathhouse stocked with wool bathing suits, plus lockers and showers, and a rooftop terrace for social events.



4. The private club initially attracted over 600 members, but construction funds never materialized for the main clubhouse, which doomed the project. However, before the club went belly up, the developer did manage to get the boathouse/bathhouse finished.

5. In 1929, four years after the completion of the building, the club sold it to CalTech, which renamed it the Kerckhoff Marine Laboratory (and still owns it today).

6. In 1931, the hotel property was foreclosed upon and turned into apartments, which were demolished six decades later. Only a historical marker remains near the corner of Carnation and Seaview Avenues.

Lauren has been the District 6 representative since 2022 and lives in Cameo Shores in Corona del Mar with her husband and their teenage son. She has been an extremely active member of the City Council, prioritizing safety and quality of life by tackling homelessness, expanding the Safety Enhancement Zone, and banning the sale of Kratom, nitrous oxide and flavored tobacco, just to name a few of her accomplishments. Mayor Kleiman has also helped bring new energy to the CDM village through initiatives such as 3rd Thursdays, the Paint the Town Mural Program, Commercial Corridor Study, and holiday décor and landscaping enhancements. She also advocates for Newport Beach's regional needs and priorities through a variety of positions: Vice Chair of the City's Aviation Committee (where she started her service as a resident committee member years ago); Vice Chair of OCCOG (Orange County Council of Governments) and SCAG (Southern California Association of Governments) Regional Council. Lauren is the first Newport Beach representative to serve on the Board of OCTA (Orange County Transit Authority).

As we welcome 2026 and Mayor Lauren Kleiman's leadership of our beautiful city by the sea, we asked her a dozen questions to learn more about her plans for her upcoming term.

- **What area do you represent?** District 6 - mostly Corona del Mar, and a little sliver of Newport Coast.
- **What are you most looking forward to as mayor?** It's an honor to earn the confidence and support of Council Colleagues as well as represent the city at functions and events locally, regionally, and beyond. I welcome the opportunity to engage with more members of the community.
- **Top 3 things you would like to accomplish as mayor?** My priorities for this year are communication, connectivity, customer service and a continued commitment to public safety - the 4 C's!

My goal is to overhaul the way the city communicates with residents and the public, so that information is more readily available where people get their news. As part of this effort, we will also be refreshing the city's website and be launching new social media campaigns to help tell our story.

I am working with the cellular carriers to identify ways to support their efforts to build new infrastructure, in non-residential areas, to address a lack of reception and connectivity in many parts of the city.

The city offers a lot of services to residents and the public, so we need to ensure that the staff is given the tools and training to provide top-notch customer service.

Lastly, as always, we maintain our commitment to support our police and fire departments and personnel to keep our residents and visitors safe.

- **Why did you decide to run for city council/Mayor?** After six years on the Planning Commission, I decided to run for City Council in 2022 after the pandemic highlighted the importance of local leadership in making decisions that impact our daily lives.
- **What is the biggest misconception about city council members?** That we are politicians. Unlike other elected representatives, we are people who live in the community we serve and want to preserve our quality of life.
- **How do you start your day?** Most days, driving the morning carpool for my son and other kids in the neighborhood.
- **The best thing about Newport Beach is:** It's a toss-up between the stunning physical landscape and the people who live here!
- **Favorite place in Newport Beach to recharge:** at home with my family.
- **A favorite place for a special meal or celebration is:** I can never get enough of Haute Cakes' pancakes!
- **Best place to watch the sunrise:** Awww...I wish I had that luxury!
- **Best place to watch the sunset:** Harbor View Hills Drive, where you can see the picturesque harbor against the panoramic backdrop of the ocean.
- **How does your day end?** Most days, after mom-taxi duties and, ideally, family dinner (if I don't have one or more city event appearances), I put my son to bed and hit the laptop to return resident emails, then research and track progress on policy items and initiatives that I'm working on.

Growing a Legacy

How Sherman Library & Gardens' "Grow The Gardens" Campaign Will Transform a Newport Beach Treasure

Walk through the gates of Sherman Library & Gardens in Corona del Mar, and you step into another world. Sunlight filters through lush canopies, koi glide across tranquil ponds, orchids sway gently in a tropical conservatory, and every pathway reveals a new delight. For decades, this 2.2-acre oasis has been a sanctuary for locals and visitors alike—a place to breathe deeply, to learn, and to celebrate nature and culture right in the heart of Newport Beach.

But beneath the beauty lies an urgent truth: much of Sherman's infrastructure has aged beyond its prime, attendance has soared, and dreams for expanded community programming far exceed the current capacity. To meet the moment, Sherman Library & Gardens has launched its most ambitious effort ever—the "Grow The Gardens" Capital Campaign, a once-in-a-generation initiative to raise \$17 million and reimagine what Sherman can be for the next 50 years.

A Beloved Garden Blossoming into the Future

Sherman Library & Gardens was born from the vision of Arnold D. Haskell in the mid-1960s and named for his mentor, Moses Hazeltine Sherman. Over the years, it has become a cherished cultural landmark, balancing horticulture, art, and history. Its landscape features a cactus and succulent garden, formal flower beds, a tropical conservatory, Mediterranean plantings and the renowned library that preserves Orange County's historical archives.

Time, however, has taken its toll. Many of Sherman's core facilities—including greenhouses, visitor areas and restrooms—haven't had significant upgrades in nearly 50 years. The conservatory and shade house struggle to maintain stable climates for delicate plant collections, while the modest Pacific Coast Highway entrance hides the treasure within from countless passersby.

Meanwhile, attendance has surged more than 50% in recent years. Families fill children's programs, school tours are booked solid, and community events regularly sell out. Demand for education, art and wellness programs is at an all-time high—but the physical space is stretched thin. Sherman's leadership realized it was time to invest boldly or risk limiting what this beloved institution could offer future generations.

What "Grow The Gardens" Will Build

The campaign's master plan preserves Sherman's historic charm while creating space for its future.

- **A New Community Building:** The current restaurant footprint will be transformed into a full-time education and program hub with classrooms, lecture space, and meeting rooms—expanding programming by at least 25%. Picture school field trips, adult gardening workshops, and evening lectures, all running seamlessly.
- **A Reimagined Restaurant in the Tea Garden:** Dining will move to a more visible and welcoming space overlooking the Tea Garden. Visitors can enjoy garden-to-table fare surrounded by lush greenery, making Sherman not just a garden but a lifestyle destination.
- **A Grand Entrance and Bell Tower:** For decades, Sherman's entrance has been an insider's secret. The redesign introduces a Spanish-inspired bell tower, ornate gates, tiled roofs, and improved signage—creating an unmistakable "front door" along Pacific Coast Highway.
- **Restoration of the Tropical Conservatory and Shade House:** Critical infrastructure upgrades will stabilize plant environments, ensuring orchids and tropical species continue to thrive.



- **A Reflection Garden:** A new sunken garden and water feature will offer a tranquil space for contemplation and commemorative bricks honoring donors.
- **Improved Accessibility:** Wider, resurfaced paths and shaded rest areas will enhance comfort and inclusivity for all visitors.

Groundbreaking is planned for early 2026, once the \$17 million goal is reached.

- **Education:** Expanded facilities will allow more school field trips, hands-on science programs, and gardening workshops, positioning Sherman as a living classroom for all ages.

- **Cultural Enrichment:** The library and gardens together preserve the region's history and biodiversity, ensuring they remain vibrant, relevant, and accessible.
- **Economic Impact:** Increased attendance will boost nearby Corona del Mar businesses and reinforce Newport Beach's reputation as a city that values culture and conservation alongside coastal glamour.
